Johnson State College offers a competency based Nonprofit Management certification that prepares students for careers in the nonprofit sector. This 18 credit certification offers flexible education by allowing the student to meet prescribed competencies through a combination with coursework and co-curricular experiences.

With the support of the Co-Director of the Career Center, students create a plan of study that requires a total of 18 credits and no more than six credits in any one competency area.
