## 2010 Graduate Survey Summary

**Overall Response Rate: 64%** (237 out of 372 graduates)  
Campus Based Undergraduates: 69% (106 of 153 graduates)  
External Degree Program: 58% (83 of 142 graduates)  
Graduate Programs: 62% (48 of 77 graduates)

### PLACEMENT DATA

**93%** (218 of 235 respondents) *reported that they are employed or continuing their education*

**73%** (172 of 235 respondents) *reported that they are employed or continuing their education in Vermont*

**77%** (132 of 171 respondents) *reported that their job is directly or somewhat related to their major*

### SALARY INFORMATION

**45%** (79 of 177 respondents) *reported salaries over \$25,000:*  
23% \$25,000 - \$34,999  
22% over \$35,000

### CAREER PREPARATION

**75%** (131 of 174 respondents) *reported that JSC provided good or excellent preparation for job/activities since graduation*

**77%** (137 of 179 respondents) *reported that their major provided good or excellent preparation for job/activities since graduation*

**31%** (57 of 184 respondents) of those who report *extracurricular or co-curricular activities say that their participation provided them with excellent or good preparation for life after JSC*

**56%** (67 out of 135 respondents) *reported participating in an internship or practicum while at JSC* - of this group:  
13% *are currently employed at the internship/practicum site*  
5% *received an offer to continue, but declined*  
20% *reported that they were hired elsewhere because of the experience gained through their internship/practicum*

## **JOB SEARCH**

**92%** (159 of 172 respondents) *reported that they found a job within 6 months to a year of graduation*
