

Health Sciences Program Assessment Plan

For overall Health Science program assessment:

- Periodic employer evaluations (every 3 years)
- Alumni surveys 1, 2 and 5 years after program completion

For Health Science Physical Education Licensure program, specifically:

- Praxis I (reading, writing, mathematics) and Praxis II (physical education content knowledge)
- Licensure portfolio (Contents are specified by Vermont Standards Board for Professional Educators, including standards-based lesson and unit plans, assessment of student learning, adapting instruction for students' special needs, student case studies, advocacy and collegiality activity, self-assessment of own learning, and vision for future professional development, along with letters of recommendation and professional resume.)
- Student teaching evaluations by College Supervisor, Cooperating Teacher(s), and licensure candidate self-evaluation (will be part of Entry 6 of Licensure portfolio)

For Health & Exercise Science program, specifically:

- Administer Health & Exercise Science professional knowledge and skill competency assessment in senior year
- Portfolio (Contents may include items such as professional resume, personal web page, videotaped presentations, evidence of fitness test administrations, documentation of exercise protocols and prescriptions, case studies, internship journals, summary of learning paper reflecting on integration of coursework and practical experiences, letters of recommendation, research papers and presentations.)
- For those students who select the internship option: Internship supervisor evaluations and student self-evaluation
- For those students who select the senior research project option: Research project public presentation (such as at on-campus departmental event or at off-campus professional meeting), including self-, faculty, and peer evaluation of the project work
