Complete the entire application (please type or print legibly) and submit it with the **required documentation** and a **\$37 application fee*** to the Office of Admissions. Please make check or money order payable, in U.S. Dollars, to Johnson State College.

PLEASE DO NOT FAX DOCUMENTS. Applications will not be reviewed until the Office of Admissions receives **all** required documentation.

Official Academic Records

Applicants with foreign academic credentials must provide academic records in the original language as well as a certified English translation. Applicants who have attended school outside the United States need to provide official results of secondary external examination, for example, West African Exam Council General Certificate of Education (GCE), and certificates of completion of secondary schooling. Official transcripts of any university level studies already completed must also be furnished.

First year students must submit:

- Completed application.
- Official high school transcript (secondary school) or mark sheet. *Transcripts must be submitted in the original language and with an English translation.*
- Official copy of the student's Leaving Certificate or Diploma, and General Certificate of Education (GCE), if applicable.
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score report, if English is not your native language.
- Financial documentation for Immigration purposes equal to one year's expenses (approximately \$28,442).
- Completed evaluation form, or one letter of recommendation preferably from a secondary school principal, guidance counselor, teacher or academic advisor.
- A writing sample (please type or print legibly).

Transfer students must submit:

- Completed application.
- Official transcript(s) from all colleges/universities previously attended** and a copy of an evaluation performed by an official credential evaluation service.. Transcripts must be submitted in the original language and with an English translation.
- Official high school transcript (secondary school) Transcripts must be submitted in the original language and with an English translation.
- Official copy of the student's Leaving Certificate or Diploma, and General Certificate of Education (GCE), if applicable.
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score report, if English is not your native language.
- Financial documentation for Immigration purposes equal to one year's expenses (approximately \$28,442).
- Completed evaluation form, or one letter of recommendation preferably from an academic dean, advisor or professor.
- A writing sample (please type or print legibly).
