Online Sources

Education Research Complete

New to our collection of online resources, this EBSCO database offers access not only to the journal literature, but to full text of books, monographs and conference papers.

ERIC (Education Resources Information Center) 1966—.

Since 1966, ERIC has been the foremost index for education research, *ERIC* provides access to almost 1000 journals as well as the report literature with coverage from 1966. The database consists of indexing for two files: *Resources in Education* (documents) and *Current Index to Journals in Education* (journal articles). The documents are now widely available in full text online. Journal articles must be requested through interlibrary loan if the title is not held by JSC in print or electronic format. Although several enhancements have improved the "free" version of ERIC on the Web, the features of our sub-subscription-based ERIC will streamline access to journals and documents in full text. Our EBSCO interface also includes an interlibrary loan request form when materials are not in full text online.

PsycINFO (*Psychological Abstracts Online*).

The JSC version (available from the Behavioral Sciences section of the Library Home Page) provides indexing from 1887--. Book chapters, dissertations and, of course, the journal literature is indexed. There are links to full text for journal titles in the *Psychological and Behavioral Sciences Collection* and the *PsycArticles* databases.
