OVERVIEW

During the spring 2003 semester, a VSC wide focus group met to examine the graduate/placement survey practices of each college. Following that meeting, Johnson State College Advising and Career Services staff met with the other VSC Career Services Directors to discuss ways to collaborate and to collect comparable data in several areas. While each college will continue to develop an individual and 'college-specific' survey, several 'common questions' and a six-month-out timing were agreed upon. Beginning in Fall 2003, Advising and Career Services conducted the first of such surveys and gathered information about graduates' employment, continuing education, job search activities, and assessments of career preparation. We are pleased with the response rate for this first year and intend to conduct similar surveys each year.

2003 Graduate Survey Summary

Overall Response Rate: 71% (220 of 308 graduates)

92% (202 of 220 respondents) *reported that they are employed or continuing their education*

42% had the job before graduation
