Overall Response Rate: 61%% (223 of 367 graduates)
Campus Based Undergraduates: 58% (103 of 178)
External Degree Program: 56% (82 of 140 graduates)
Graduate Programs: 61% (38 of 62 graduates)

PLACEMENT DATA

99% (221 of 223 respondents) *reported that they are employed or continuing their education*
11% are continuing education on a full or part time basis

82% (154 of 187 respondents) *reported that their job is directly or somewhat related to their major*
65% directly related
17% somewhat related

SALARY INFORMATION

62% (112 of 183 respondents) *reported salaries over \$25,000:*
37% \$25,000 - \$34,999
25% over \$35,000

CAREER PREPARATION

76% (137 of 181 respondents) *reported that JSC provided good or excellent preparation for job/activities since graduation*

78% (141 of 180 respondents) *reported that their major provided good or excellent preparation for job/activities since graduation*

80% (60 of 75 respondents) of those who report *extracurricular or co-curricular activities say that their participation provided them with excellent or good preparation for life after JSC*

52% (87 of 166 respondents) *reported participating in an internship or practicum while at JSC.*

25% *are currently employed at the internship/practicum site*

7% *received an offer to continue, but declined*

47% *reported that they were hired elsewhere because of the experience gained through their internship/practicum*
