2007 Graduate Survey Summary

Overall Response Rate: 70% (247 of 355 graduates)
Campus Based Undergraduates: 70% (105 of 150)
External Degree Program: 66% (91 of 139 graduates)
Graduate Programs: 79% (51 of 65 graduates)

PLACEMENT DATA

97% (239 of 247 respondents) *reported that they are employed or continuing their education*

11% are continuing education

83% are employed or continuing education in Vermont

77% (117 of 152 respondents) *reported that their job is directly or somewhat related to their major*

SALARY INFORMATION

76% (113 of 149 respondents) *reported salaries over \$25,000:*

30% \$25,000 - \$34,999

46% over \$35,000

CAREER PREPARATION

72% (112 of 155 respondents) *reported that JSC provided good or excellent preparation for job/activities since graduation*

81% (122 of 151 respondents) *reported that their major provided good or excellent preparation for job/activities since graduation*

81% (46 of 57 respondents) of those who report *extracurricular or co-curricular activities say that their participation provided them with excellent or good preparation for life after JSC*

Career Preparation Cont.

55% (82 of 148 respondents) *reported participating in an internship or practicum while at JSC.*

of this group:

26% are currently employed at the internship/practicum site

12% received an offer to continue, but declined

42% reported that they were hired elsewhere because of the experience gained through their internship/practicum
