Overall Response Rate: 67% (261 out of 391 graduates)
Campus Based Undergraduates: 59% (86 of 147 graduates)

65% (107 of 165 respondents) *reported salaries over \$25,000:*
26% \$25,000 - \$34,999
39% over \$35,000

CAREER PREPARATION

75% (133 of 175 respondents) *reported that JSC provided good or excellent preparation for job/activities since graduation*

75% (126 of 169 respondents) *reported that their major provided good or excellent preparation for job/activities since graduation*

30% (52 of 176 respondents) of those who report *extracurricular or co-curricular activities say that their participation provided them with excellent or good preparation for life after JSC*

43% (68 of 160 respondents) *reported participating in an internship or practicum while at JSC* - of this group:
11% *are currently employed at the internship/practicum site*
4% *received an offer to continue, but declined*
