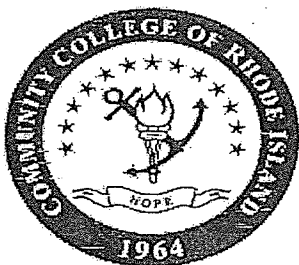




TRANSFER AGREEMENT


Between the Community College of Rhode Island
and
Johnson State College

1. Johnson State College assures the acceptance of an associate degree graduate who has earned a grade point average of 2.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) into a baccalaureate degree program. Students who are accepted with 60 transfer credits will be classified as juniors.
2. Transfer students will receive academic credit for all college-level courses in which they have earned "C-" grades or higher that are applied toward the requirements of the associate degree.
3. Non-credit or remedial courses adjudged to be below college level may not be accepted for transfer.
4. It is understood that if a student does not have the foundation or skill to enroll in an upper level course because he/she has not taken introductory courses, he/she will be required to take any necessary prerequisites(s). Therefore Johnson State College cannot assure every student the completion of requirements for the baccalaureate degree in four semesters.
5. The Johnson State College catalog contains all information about degree requirements. Students wishing to plan their associate degree program to ensure meeting prerequisites for upper division courses are encouraged to communicate early with the transfer counselor at Johnson State College to secure specific information about transfer credits.
6. This agreement will be reviewed bi-annually and may be revised by mutual agreement.
7. The agreement is expected to continue in force indefinitely but may be terminated by either party with not less than one year's notice.
