Exception: Students who have an associate degree do not need to take this exam or MAT 1080. (However, all students need to take and pass a quantitatively enriched [QE] course to meet part II of the standard.)

If you need to take the exam, please contact your advisor and ask to be registered to take GRS-2000 on one of the following testing dates/times.

The exam will appear on your portal page looking like an online course. You can take the exam wherever you have access to the Internet. There is no cost to take this assessment, and it can be done only twice.

Note: You must pass the Quantitative Reasoning Assessment, or MAT 1080, or have an associate's degree before you can enroll in a quantitatively enriched (QE) course. Passing a QE course is required to meet the graduation standard in Quantitative Reasoning.
