All the courses for which you are registered should appear on your Portal Page. Click on the name of your online course and you will enter the Blackboard site for this course. You will enter by way of the Announcements Page. To the left are buttons that direct

you through the class. You should enter each of the different areas to familiarize yourself with the site. Much of your online work will be in the Discussion area.

Make sure that your JSC email address is your address in Blackboard. Do NOT change your email address in Blackboard to a personal email address. Your JSC email account is the official email address that the faculty and other parts of the College use to contact you electronically. If you miss important information because you've changed your address in Blackboard, neither the College nor EDP is responsible. Also, note that periodically during the semester the system is refreshed and all email addresses revert to the JSC email address.
